



CQUniversity Australia 2013 Tuition Fee Schedule - Domestic students

The 2013 Tuition Fee Schedule is effective from 15 February 2013 and replaces all Schedules previously issued. Tuition Fees are reviewed annually and whenever possible published on 1st October each year for the following year.

Tuition Fees for each course of enrolment are calculated per unit of credit. Except where otherwise indicated, examples of “Fee per Course” in the Schedule assume that fees are calculated for:

- a standard UNDERGRADUATE course of 6 units of credit; or
- a standard POSTGRADUATE course of 8 units of credit.

Courses may, however, have a unit of credit value different to the standard value – please check the **Student Handbook** for information on units of credit per course. <http://handbook.cqu.edu.au/>

Fees applicable to domestic students for each course offered by CQUniversity are also published in the Cost per Course table at <http://www.cqu.edu.au/current-student/student-fees/fees-and-charges/cost-per-course>.

Students are advised to check the **Calendar of Principal Dates** in the **Student Handbook** each term for information about the last date to withdraw without financial penalty.
