CQUniversity's professionally recognised Master of Clinical Chiropractic will equip you to meet the professional practice requirements set by the Council on Chiropractic Education Australasia (CCEA). This will allow you to apply for registration as a chiropractor in Australia and New Zealand.

This course is designed as an extended six-term master's degree. Each term you will have the opportunity to complete a clinical placement in an approved external clinic as well as CQUniversity's brand new and highly resourced clinics. Our theoretical courses afford you great flexible learning options.

As a graduate, you will be a practice ready, competent chiropractor with diagnostic skills that can be applied in a professional, safe, ethical and lawful manner. You will be required to demonstrate leadership and be able to communicate the benefits of chiropractic care to health care consumers.

Work integrated learning

You will get the opportunity to undertake a clinical placement in each term in an approved external clinic as well as CQUniversity's brand new and highly resourced clinics. Opportunities are provided in international placement, regional and rural health engagement, and indigenous healthcare. You will also undertake industry recognised specialty technique training including rehabilitation.

CQUniversity's Mackay student Chiropractic Clinic partners with Hands On Health Australia (HoHA) to provide chiropractic care to those in need, supervised by CQUniversity's qualified chiropractors. This partnership is a great way for CQUni students to give back to the community and to gain additional hands-on experience. The Mackay clinic is one of only 11 volunteer community clinics in Australia and four international treatment and training programs.

Professional recognition

As a graduate, you will meet the competencies required by the CCEA. You will therefore be eligible to apply for registration with the Chiropractic Board of Australia (CBA). As the course is fully accredited, you will have the opportunity to travel and work in different countries (please check the individual requirements of each country).

Career opportunities

There are opportunities for employment in private practice, sports medicine, occupational health and safety, rehabilitation and other allied health fields. Our graduates are highly sought after which is evident by our 100% employment rate over the past three years. Musculoskeletal healthcare is a growing field and the demand for healthcare professionals in this field is expected to grow over the coming years. Chiropractors are considered by governments around the world as essential healthcare workers which is a great recognition of our profession and speaks to the growing utilisation of chiropractic globally.



Hands-on practical experience is highly sought after by employers and is a key component of CQUniversity's Master of Clinical Chiropractic. Our students are involved in a number of outreach programs such as providing on-field care at the North Queensland Games, traveling abroad to provide care and assistance to under served communities and as active participants caring for participants in large scale charity events. At CQUniversity engaging with our local communities and supporting its members is an important part of our training.

Entry requirements

ACADEMIC

Successful completion of CQUniversity's Bachelor of Science (Chiropractic); or a three-year, six-term equivalent undergraduate chiropractic course accredited by the Council on Chiropractic Education Australasia (CCEA).

ENGLISH

Minimum academic IELTS of 7.0 in each band and overall or equivalent.

SCHOLARSHIPS

You may be eligible for the International Student Scholarship (Brisbane) or the International Student Scholarship – Regional (Mackay). Both scholarships award recipients up to the value of 25% of your tuition fee for the duration of the course. If you choose to study in Mackay, you will not need to apply for the scholarship – the scholarship will be automatically offered to you provided all terms and conditions are met.

You can study in bustling Brisbane with easy access to public transport; or thriving Mackay where you have the option to live on-campus in our student accommodation. You can also gain a multi-campus study experience by transferring your study credits to a different campus and see more of Australia. If you have been awarded a scholarship, you will be able to retain your scholarship when you transfer to a different campus.
