

## 2017 Tuition Fee Schedule – International Students



This 2017 Tuition Fee Schedule is effective from 1 January 2017 and replaces all Schedules previously issued. Tuition Fees are reviewed annually and can increase from year to year.

**Tuition Fees for each unit of study are calculated per credit point.** Except where otherwise indicated, examples of “Fee per Unit” in the Schedule assume a standard unit of **6 credit points**. Individual units may, however, have a credit point value different to the standard value – please check the **Student Handbook** (<http://handbook.cqu.edu.au/>) for information on credit points for each unit.
