

2019 Tuition Fee Schedule – Domestic Students



This 2019 Tuition Fee Schedule is effective from 1 January 2019 and replaces all Schedules previously issued. Tuition Fees are reviewed annually and can increase from year to year. Whenever possible Tuition Fees are published on 1 October each year for the following year.

Tuition Fees for each unit of study are calculated per credit point. Except where otherwise indicated, examples of “Fee per Unit” in the Schedule assume a standard unit of **6 credit points**. Individual units may, however, have a credit point value different to the standard value – please check the **Student Handbook** (<https://handbook.cqu.edu.au/>) for information on credit points for each unit.

Fees for each unit offered by CQUniversity to domestic students are also published in the Cost per Unit (Domestic students) table at <https://www.cqu.edu.au/student-life/student-finances/fees-and-charges/degree-level-students>.
