1 PURPOSE

1.1 This procedure outlines the approved teaching qualifications and process for recognising additional teaching qualifications for vocational education and training (VET) Educators at CQUniversity.

2 SCOPE

2.1 This procedure applies to CQUniversity VET Educators.

3 PROCEDURE

- 3.1 CQUniversity will appoint VET Educators to the relevant salary scale outlined in the <u>Central Queensland University Enterprise Agreement 2017</u> commensurate with the VET Educator's educational/industry qualifications and experience and in accordance with the Classification Descriptors outlined in the Enterprise Agreement. (Also refer to the Guide to Minimum Teachers' Salaries at Appointment.)
- 3.2 Before VET Educators can progress beyond Step 4 of the salary scale, VET Educators at CQUniversity must possess an 'approved teaching qualification'. This requirement also applies for salary recognition at appointment, and when being considered for relieving in higher classified positions that require an approved teaching qualification in accordance with this procedure and the <u>Higher Duties Policy and Procedure</u>.
- 3.3 The <u>Australian Skills Quality Authority</u> (ASQA) also requires that VET training and assessment is delivered by people with a minimum Certificate IV in Training and Assessment (TAE40110 or TAE40116) or its successor, or a diploma or higher level qualification in adult education.

Approved teaching qualifications

- 3.4 Employees will be deemed to have an approved teaching qualification when they can demonstrate:
 - a) registration with the Queensland College of Teachers (QCT)
 - b) completion of a course of study satisfying the eligibility requirements for qualification recognition by the QCT, or

- c) completion of a course of study recognised by CQUniversity and included in <u>Appendix 1: Approved</u> Teaching Qualifications for VET Educators.
- 3.5 Employees must demonstrate proof of eligibility for QTC recognition or proof of course completion by presenting an original or certified copy of an academic record or transcript to the People and Culture Directorate (pac@cqu.edu.au).

Application for higher level qualification recognition

- 3.6 Employees without an approved teaching qualification as defined by this procedure may apply to the University for their completed qualification to be recognised.
- 3.7 Employees applying for recognition of a teaching qualification must demonstrate proof of course completion by presenting an original or certified copy of an academic record or transcript to the People and Culture Directorate (pac@cqu.edu.au). The Directorate will liaise with Learning and Teaching Services to decide if the qualification is acceptable.
- 3.8 The University will consider degree qualifications as per the following categories when considering such applications:
 - a) possession of a minimum three-year Bachelor Degree in education or training from a recognised tertiary education provider, with a focus on adult education. The qualification must include as part of the degree, a minimum of 50 hours supervised teaching in an educational setting
 - b) possession of a minimum three-year vocational Bachelor Degree e.g. engineering, business, etc., together with postgraduate qualifications at a minimum one year fulltime equivalent at Graduate Diploma level in adult education or training from a recognised tertiary education provider. A minimum of 50 hours supervised teaching in a vocational education setting must be included as part of the qualification, or
 - c) Where a teacher presents with a qualification, which does not include 50 hours supervised teaching in a vocational education setting, assessment of the qualification and any relevant teaching experience will be undertaken by Learning and Teaching Services, in consultation with relevant stakeholders. If the qualification is deemed acceptable, it will be included in Appendix 1 as an approved higher level teaching qualification.
- 3.9 An acceptable qualification will be recognised as an approved teaching qualification and listed in Appendix 1.

Existing VET educators

3.10 VET Educators employed before 1 July 2014 and who are currently employed by the University and deemed to have an approved teaching qualification will be considered to have the qualification under this procedure.

4 RESPONSIBILITIES

Compliance, monitoring and review

- 4.1 The Pro Vice-Chancellor (VET Operations and Growth) is responsible for implementing, monitoring, reviewing this procedure and Appendix.
- 4.2 The Director, People and Culture is responsible for ensuring compliance with this procedure.

Reporting

4.3 No additional reporting is required.

Records management

- 4.4 Employees must manage records in accordance with the <u>Records Management Policy and Procedure</u>. This includes retaining these records in a recognised University recordkeeping information system.
- 4.4 University records must be retained for the minimum periods specified in the University Sector Retention and Disposal Schedule on the <u>Queensland State Archives website</u>.
